

## WESTMOUNT RECYCLES

First BOTTLE DRIVE of the YEAR  
**Thursday, September 15**

8:00 - 8:45 AM and 3:00 - 3:45 PM Mid-High Campus  
8:15 - 9:00 AM and 3:15 - 4:00 PM Elementary Campus

New to Westmount, or haven't participated before? Here's how it works:

"Drive-Thru" drop offs are set in the Church parking lot for the Mid-High campus and in front of the Elementary campus just around the corner from the buses. Follow the signs!

Load up recyclables in bags or boxes that you don't need returned. Stop in the drive-through and a wonderful volunteer will unload for you! You just drive away to make way for the next person.

We collect **ALL BEVERAGE CONTAINERS**: milk containers, pop cans, beer bottles, tetra packs, wine bottles, plastic water bottles, anything that is accepted at the depot.

We are partnered with **Vecova Bottle Depot** to pick up, sort, count and recycle our bottles.

Vecova operates the only not for profit bottle depot in the city and do some great work in our community, take a moment to check them out:

### BOTTLE DRIVE ETIQUETTE:

- Please watch carefully for children!
- Do not stop in or block cross-walks
- Bring bottles in bags or boxes you **DO NOT** need returned
- Be kind to the Vecova employees - remember to **remove caps/corks from your empties**
- Swish and Squish Milk containers
- Leave the drive-through promptly to make room for the next person

**PLEASE BE AWARE OF THE WEIGHT OF YOUR BAGS**, particularly with glass bottles!

The truck deck is approx 4 ft above the ground – if the bags tear we end up with a lot of broken glass!

**NOTE:** We are no longer partnering with Think Recycle as of September 2014.

Laptops, peripherals, cell phones etc can be recycled at your local Staples or Future Shop.

Ink Cartridges are accepted for recycling at Island Ink and other stores that offer ink cartridge refill services.
